from the past we see women in different guises as workers cultivating silk worms to their role as concubines the delights and perils of that occupation and ending with the sending away of a young girl to an arranged marriage we look at the imperial examination system a key factor in maintaining governance of the empire over two thousand years also examined is the expression of dissidence in the political system of social waywardness and debauchery and the moral character instilled in different ways with the three major religions or philosophies of china daoist confucian and buddhist finally a number of chinese poems have made their way to the west in translation and we go back and look at the sources for a couple of these poems while an assortment of thirty odd tang dynasty poems is clearly just skimming the surface of the wealth of chinese poetry in existence the aim by finding poems which link to aspects of chinese culture is to provide as varied a collection as possible making the reading of these poems more accessible and their study more rewarding
